





Led by Principal Conductor Theodore Kuchar, the symphony is renowned for their performances of the works of Janaček and other significant Czech composers such as Dvořák, Smetana and Martiná, however the Orchestra's repertoire goes far beyond the works of Czech composers, and includes, to name a few, the works of Beethoven, Mozart, Schubert, R. Strauss, Reger, Szymanowski, Schumann, Bruch, and Bruckner.

Box Office hours are 11 AM to 5 PM Monday through Friday, closed Saturday and Sunday unless otherwise specified. On performance days, the Box Office will remain open one-half hour after curtain and during intermission.

### Weekend Performances

For Saturday or Sunday performances, the Box Office will open two hours prior to curtain time unless otherwise specified.

### Holidays

Unless there is a scheduled performance, the Luhrs Center is closed the same days that the University is closed with some rare exceptions. The Luhrs Center is closed the following holidays: Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. Please check [luhrscenter.com](http://luhrscenter.com) for specific closing dates.

### Tours

The Luhrs Center offers tours for individuals or groups during normal operation hours, 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday or at prearranged times. The tour is led by an employee or a volunteer of the Center and includes Grove Theatre, backstage, Green Room, VIP dressing rooms, and cast dressing rooms. Please contact the Front of House Manager at 717.477.1123 x3302 to schedule a tour. Please note that tours may not be available on performance days.



### Children

All children are required to hold tickets for performances at the Luhrs Center and must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult in all areas of the Luhrs Center, especially Grove Theatre. 

### Directions


