The major goal of She Devil MotorSports is to have the largest women's motorcycle rally in Western North America and across Canada. They plan to do this my hosting an annual women's motorcycle rally. In the future Julianne plans to expand the business interests into publishing a magazine targeting women motorcyclist in Canada. She also plans to have a website up and running by the end of the month.

The rally will be held in mid September. It will be a three day event that is estimated to bring in \$150,000 in revenue for the local economy. The rally's attendance for 2009 is expected to surpass 200 women.

The rally will bring in people as far away as Washington State and the prairies. With so many people attending there will be a safety supervisor that will have a free vendor's both. There will have a drive to survive to prevent drinking and driving.

The event will also include activities like a poker run, parade, stunt show, self-guided tours with courtesy maps, vendors, guests speakers like "the wrench wench," and a BBQ. Registration is \$25 and provides a dog tag for admittance to the events, as well as discounts at anticipating hotels, local pubs and stores.
