## core services

Early intervention is a key to successful recovery from alcohol or drug dependency. BACODA's OSAR services include screenings, assessments and referrals and short term and/or bilingual counseling. OSAR can also help with accessing state funding treatment at no cost. Other Core services include DOT Assessments and ASI Assessments, among other resources.

## business

**BACODA Business Assistance Program**—Serving the business community, our goal is to develop a drug free business community in the Bay Area. Trained BACODA staff can assist with developing policies that fit the specific needs of your business, train supervisors on how to enforce policies and educate your staff on following policies.

## prevention

**Youthworks**—Prevention/intervention services in eleven school districts throughout Brazoria, Galveston, Harris and Matagorda counties. Prevention education consists of groups focusing on substance abuse prevention, including communication, conflict resolution and peer pressure skills. Alternative activities and tobacco presentations are free of charge.

## Healing Field®

There is no other program like the Healing Field® flag memorial. A Healing Field® event is a community event, charitable fund raiser, awareness program and an amazing and unifying experience for all involved. A field of flags conveys a powerful message. What started out as a way to commemorate the lives of those lost to us on September 11, 2001, has grown into something more. Communities across America are turning to Healing Field® flag memorials to raise money and awareness for a growing array of causes.

BACODA – the Bay Area Council on Drugs & Alcohol’s Healing Field® event will honor those lost to alcohol-related motor vehicle fatalities in the State of Texas in one year. Acres of red, white and blue will stand eight feet tall in perfect rows similar to those in Arlington Cemetery. The three feet by five feet flags will stand as a temporary memorial but will make a lasting impression on those who stand before them.
