The Life Center is a community-based program that provides a variety of health, social, and related support services in a congregate setting during daytime hours. The Life Center assists persons to improve or maintain their level of functioning through utilization of individualized plans of service which consider each person's needs, interests, and abilities.

What can we offer the *participant?*
