BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Amasong was founded in 1990 in Champaign-Urbana, Illinois by Kristina Boerger who was about to begin her master's degree in choral conducting at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Amasong provides an opportunity for lesbians and feminist women to gather together in the pursuit of choral excellence. The group's name was a play on the words *amazon* and *song*. The choir's first members were diverse in interest, age, and experience, and this has continued to the present version of the chorus. Amasong's repertoire draws most heavily upon folk music from various world traditions, music written by women, and other music reflecting women's experiences. The Board of Directors was established in 1995 to oversee the organizational, promotional, and financial matters of the chorus. Amasong has released multiple CDs, some of which have won Gay and Lesbian American Music Awards, and has been the feature of a PBS documentary entitled "Singing Out." SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of eight series: music, administrative, media, finances, correspondence, photographs, choral operations, and the subject file.

The collection includes correspondence, financial records, photographs, programs, minutes, sheet music, by-laws, and other working papers produced by Amasong and its members. The collection covers the activities of the chorus and the Board of Directors.

Two strengths of the collection include the concert program files (1994-2008) and the correspondence files (1997-2008). Taken together, these two sets of papers thoroughly document both the formal and informal, external and internal, activities of Amasong.

ARRANGEMENT

Music

This alphabetically-organized series is chiefly composed of copies of the sheet music from Amasong performances, but also includes unsolicited sheet music samples sent to Amasong.

Administrative

This series includes minutes from the meetings of the Board of Directors, ranging from the creation of the Board in 1995 through 2009. The series includes other materials pertaining to the operation of the Board, including board and singer contact information, by-laws, and information about each of the Board positions and Board-appointed positions, including music director and chorus manager. The folders are organized alphabetically, with the minutes and other selective folders arranged chronologically.

Media

This series includes publicity materials and press coverage for performances, CDs, and the DVD. It also includes production information for the CDs and the website. It is organized alphabetically, with some folders arranged chronologically.

Financial

This series includes treasurer's reports, tax forms, invoices, receipts, insurance information, contracts, and investment statements. The highlights of this series are the 501(c)(3) documents and the Articles of Incorporation.

Correspondence

The chronologically-organized correspondence series is one of the strengths of the collection. It primarily consists of printouts of email correspondence among members of the Board of Directors. Spanning from 1997 to 2008, it thoroughly documents the development of the chorus.

Photographs

The photographic documentation is especially strong for the chorus trip to the Czech Republic.

Choral Operations

This series contains materials relating to the operation and organization of the chorus, including concerts and rehearsals. The highlight of this series is the collection of concert programs. Although lacking the early years of Amasong's existence, the concert programs document the bi-annual performances of Amasong from 1994 through 2008. The series is organized alphabetically, with concert program files arranged chronologically.

Subject File

The subject file exists to organize the materials relating to Amasong's connection to various associations, such as GALA Choruses and the Gay and Lesbian American Music Awards (GLAMA), and materials relating to Amasong's participation in annual special events, such as the National Women's Music Festival. This series is organized alphabetically.
