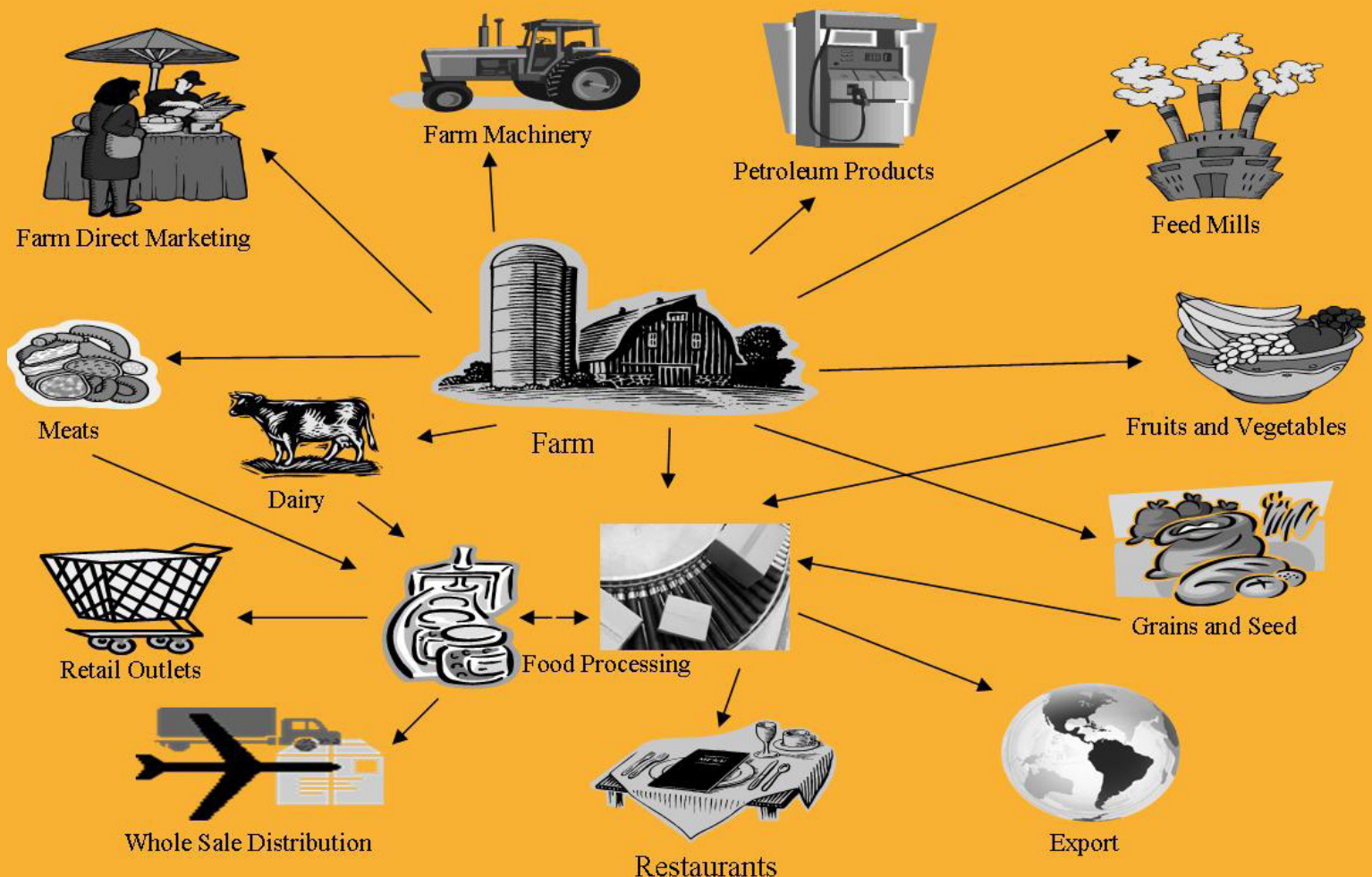




## Agri-Food Leadership Diploma
