Sophomore courses in which some PMC students will enroll include: MC 2003, MC 2023, SC 2183, SPM 2843. You will need to have at least a 2.5 GPA to be given permission to move onto these classes. MC 2003 and MC 2023 require that you have finished English Composition with a C or better.
