Skywave Writers is a creative writing group located in the San Francisco area. We welcome writers of any level, any background, especially those who have never put pen to paper and just need encouragement to begin! This workshop is not a class. There is no homework. Our sole purpose is to encourage writers to keep on writing.

We use writing exercises and prompts to begin the process. We write individually in fifteen minute segments, then re-group to share what we have written, if the writer chooses to do so. Commentary is given by the group as to what felt strong in the writing and what we liked.

If you are working on a manuscript of your own, feel free to use the workshop time to continue progressing on it. Instead of using the writing prompts, you can simply carry on with your project and share whatever piece you have added during the writing segment, if you so choose.

If you would like to bring in a work-inprogress for a more in-depth critique, please do! You can bring copies (no more than a 25 page excerpt at a time) that the group can take home to read over and make notes in the margins as to what was strong, what we liked and also what pulled us out.
