May 2012	Cum Laude Distinction	Cum laude distinction received following the completion of my Joint European Masters degree in International Migration and Social Cohesion.
September 2010	Erasmus Mundus Scholarship	This scholarship, funded by the European Commission, is awarded to students admitted to an Erasmus Mundus graduate program and is based on both academic merit and work experience. I was ranked 2 nd overall out of over 300 applications from around the world.
June 2009	Academic Award of Excellence	This award is presented to the individual who achieves the highest overall honours average in Humber College's Public Administration program.
August 2008	Finland's Centre for International Mobility (CIMO) Scholarship	This scholarship was awarded to assist in funding my work at the Institute of Migration in Turku, Finland through the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada's (AUCC) Finnish-Canadian Exchange Program.
April 2008	David Dodge Award for Public Service Excellence	This annual award recognizes leadership, community service and outstanding academic achievement in Humber College's post graduate program in Public Administration.
