





Designing Process

- Information was also used that fellow colleges gathered when researching feedback tools.






Observational Research

Signage & Entrance






- Additional standing signage can bring more attention to the library and promote events.







Music & Culture

This area could also be better used by displaying information on musicians and types of music so people take notice it is available.








Music & Culture

- Bringing in more contemporary art could also get younger generations interested in art and the exhibitions at the library.








Path to Active IT

- Increased popularity of Active IT could open up possibilities for better technology.









Study & Tables
