- Music artist and athlete endorsements ranked highest among consumers purchasing headphones under \$20 and over \$100, and sales of headphones over \$100 are growing.
- Headphones \$100 or more went from around 2 percent of the headphone market in 2009 to 3.5 percent of the market in 2010.
- Overall stereo headphone sales increased 17 percent in units and 30 percent in dollars in 2010.
- Consumers said they bought a new pair of headphones every 14 months, but teenagers reported buying new ones even more frequently.
- Teenagers were almost twice as likely as the average consumer to say they plan to purchase new headphones in the next year.
- Models under \$100 make up the majority of headphone sales, models priced above \$100 have doubled their unit share to 6 percent, and now account for more than \$342 million in sales through November of 2011.


