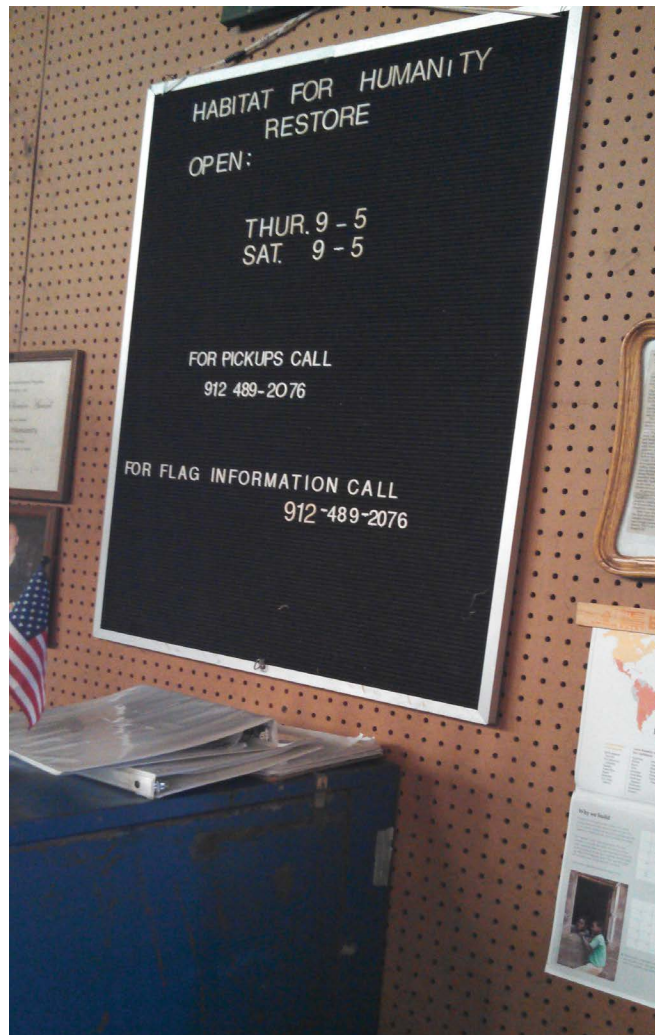


About Habitat

Habitat for Humanity of Bulloch County is a non-profit, housing ministry seeking to eliminate housing poverty, and to make decent shelter a matter of conscience and action. Habitat invites people from all walks of life to work together in partnership to build houses with families in need. Since its start in 1991, Habitat for Humanity of Statesboro has built more than 3 dozen homes throughout Bulloch County.

Habitat for Humanity of Bulloch County serves Bulloch County, Georgia, and is directed by a volunteer board of directors, with a full-time Executive Director, Office Manager and part-time Construction Manager.

Habitat for Humanity of Bulloch County is not a charity or a give-away program. Habitat for Humanity builds houses with Bulloch County families in need. Volunteer labor is used to keep building costs low for Habitat families.

Construction of a Habitat home does not begin with the volunteers you see working on the house. But with the generosity of local residents who donate cash, or materials for homes, who help sponsor houses or donate items to the Habitat ReStore. Except for occasional grants, all money to build Habitat homes is raised locally, in Bulloch County.

Note:

We cannot accept: clothing, heavily soiled furniture or mattresses, or broken appliances. Store staff may decline donations if they feel the items are not salvageable, or could pose a risk to staff or buyers. Items for pickup should be disassembled and ready to load, with the exception of items such as beds, which can be disassembled without tools.
